

# Learning Communities – 2008

**Honors students** should select LC 30, as this LC meets two of the Honors requirements, and is reserved for Honors students who will not have AP English credit.

**Leadership students** who anticipate AP English credit should avoid LCs 1-14, and may wish to consider LC 29 which is reserved for Leadership students. Those who are also Honors students may select LC 30.

**Non-residential students** should select LC 28 if they will not have AP English credit.

LCs 1-14 combine English 123 (which is required of all majors) with another course. If you anticipate AP credit for English 123 you should focus on LCs 15-27.

- LCs 1-3 combine English 123 and a Natural World Area of Inquiry (AofI) course and are suitable for all majors except Biology, Chemistry, and Computer Engineering.
