

## Learning Communities – 2009

LCs 1-13 combine English 123 (which is required of all majors) with another course. If you anticipate AP credit for English 123 you should focus on LCs 14-27. LC 28 is reserved for commuter students, while LCs 29 and 30 are designed for PLP students.
