

## Procedure for non-BIOL majors to register for BIOL courses

1. You must be registered with the Pre-med & Pre-health Program as a pre-Health student (<http://www.cnu.edu/prehealth/registration/index.asp>)
2. Make an appointment to see the Director of Pre-health Programs (DPP - Dr. Gwynne Brown, 594-7782/8255, [gwynne.brown@cnu.edu](mailto:gwynne.brown@cnu.edu)) to discuss your academic and career plans; if the DPP agrees that the desired course is appropriate at this time, she will give you a signed note requesting that you be signed into the course(s)
3. Take the note from the DPP to the BCES Department Chair (Dr. Edward Weiss), along with a completed Add-Drop form for the course(s); *if there is space available in the course*, the Chair will sign your Add-Drop form
4. Take the signed Add-Drop form to the Registrar during registration or add-drop period

To enroll in:

- BIOL 211/211L - complete the steps above (note: CHEM 121/121L or CHEM 103/103L is a pre- or co-requisite)
- BIOL 213/213L - complete the steps above ; you must have completed CHEM 121/121L - 122/122L or CHEM 103/103L - CHEM 104/104L, **and** BIOL 211/211L, all with a grade of 'C' or better, **and** have an overall GPA of 2.8 or better
- 300- and 400-level BIOL courses (e.g., 301/301L, 307/307L, 313, 314/314L) - complete the steps above; you must have completed BIOL 211/211L (C or better) & BIOL 213/213L (C+ or better), plus one year of CHEM\*\* (C or better); **and** at least a 2.5 GPA average in these courses and have overall GPA of 2.8 or better

\*\* CHEM 321/321L-322/322L *recommended* for BIOL 307 & **required** for BIOL 414
